MAIN OPERATIONS

Survey, verify, and clear UNISFA priority routes and Joint Border Verification and Monitoring Mechanism (JBVMM) to ensure safe passage

SPECIFIC TASKS

- Route survey
- Route verification using Vehicle Mounted Mine Detection (VMMDS) and Explosive and Drug Detection (EDDS) systems
- Route clearance using manual mine clearance and mine detection dogs
- Awareness raising on explosive hazards

CURRENT CAPACITY

Two teams

TEAM COMPOSITION

Eight people for VMMDS and EDDS and twelve people for manual mine clearance, four mine detection dogs (MDD) and EOD specialists.

Survey and clear UNISFA and JBVMM Safe Demilitarised Border Zone (SDBZ) priority areas of explosive hazards

- Non-technical and technical survey
- Explosive ordnance disposal (EOD)
- Battle area clearance
- Manual mine clearance
- Mechanical clearance capacity
- Awareness raising on explosive hazards

Four teams

Twelve people per clearance team (team leader, EOD specialist, deminers, drivers, medic and mechanical clearance specialist).

Provide JBVMM ground patrols with mine protected vehicles and demining crews to safely patrol the SDBZ

- Safely transport JBVMM ground patrol teams
- Explosive ordnance disposal
- Battle area clearance
- Manual mine clearance
- Medical support
- Mechanical support

Five teams

Six people (driver, deminers, commander, medic, mechanic and radio operator) supporting a JBVMM ground patrol team. Three mine protected vehicles per team.

Provide UNISFA with technical support and equipment in weapons and ammunition destruction in the Abyei Administrative Area

- Development of standard operating procedures for WAM
- Construction and maintenance of storage site and equipment including storage containers, weapon cutting shears and ammunition burners
- Safe storage and destruction of confiscated weapons and ammunition

UNMAS, UNISFA troops and UNPOL

UNMAS WAM Officer, UNISFA military and police components.

Provide landmine/ERW risk awareness to UNISFA personnel and communities at risk in the Abyei Administrative Area

- Mine/ERW induction briefing for UNISFA and JBVMM personnel
- Mine risk education programmes for local and nomadic communities in Abyei
- Mine/ERW awareness briefing for humanitarian actors
